Effective July 1, 2014, a new regulation will require health and safety awareness training for workers under the Occupational Health and Safety Act (OHSA). The contents of the training provided to workers should include the following:

In addition to the Health & Safety Awareness training requirements, all Employers should ensure that workers on trained on the following:

- ✓ Specific hazards in your workplace
- ✓ The procedure to follow when reporting health and safety concerns, incidents or injuries
- \checkmark Any protective equipment you are required to wear or use
- ✓ Where the company's health and safety policy is posted (in workplaces with more than 5 workers)
- ✓ Where the first aid station is and the names of qualified first aid providers
- ✓ The company's emergency plan
- ✓ Information on hazardous materials in your workplace
- ✓ The workplace violence and harassment prevention policy
- ✓ Where a copy of the OHSA is posted
- ✓ Where the names of your joint health and safety committee members are posted

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
